**Work on 2021 Budget**

The Commissioners and Auditor worked on the requests and funding sources for the proposed 2022 budget.

Highway Superintendent Jamie Broksieck was available for questions and submitted a request list in regards to the Road and Bridge budget for 2022. Sheriff Cory Borg was present for discussion and also explained his requests in regards to his department. Much of the Sheriff's budget increased due to absorbing costs from the 911 budget which is a restricted budget and costs must be directed to public safety.

Discussion was concentrated on economic development. The Board thought it best to hold a special meeting in August before the provisional budget for 2022 is approved and notice of hearing published.
