

4-H Record Book

Directions for completion

Do Not include club minutes. Those are for the secretary's book.

Do Not include ribbons. They should be in your scrapbook. However, if you like, take a picture of your ribbons arranged neatly. Then, include your picture on the picture page.

Current Year's Book

- Should be on the top followed by all the past year's books

Annual Report

- Fill out **Completely**
- Include names of **ALL** club members

Page 2

- Complete page 2 for each month even if you did not attend
- Be sure to **check the box** if you attended the meeting

Livestock Forms

- Use a separate livestock form for each species
- Fill out each section
- If you do not show livestock, you may leave this page out
- Rodeo should include the livestock form for Horse unless all you compete in is rough stock.

Cumulative Reports

- Use one line per year per event
- Add pages as needs
- Pull **ALL** cumulative pages forward
- Be sure to include your demonstration or talk
- Use **Cumulative Report 5: Project Exhibits** to list all display exhibits, livestock exhibits, and rodeo events at the county and state level. Feel free to record any time you displayed/showed your 4-H project even if it was not a 4-H event.
- Horse project members should include all classes from County and State 4-H Horse Show. Feel free to record any time you participated in an event with your horse even if it was not a 4-H event.
- Use **Cumulative Report 7: Community Service** to list all community service projects you were involved in even if they were not 4-H events.
