4-H is an organization for youth ages 8 to 19 that belongs to the members and the volunteer leaders who work with the program.

4-H is youth sharing, doing and learning together in all kinds of projects, events and activities with the guidance of volunteer leaders.



Members choose projects that fit their interests. Whether you are from a rural area or the city, 4-H offers something for everyone.

Group activities and events such as camps, trips, fairs, shows and conferences provide additional opportunities and learning experiences in addition to the traditional club membership experience.



What do 4-H members do?

1. Join a club. There are several clubs in Deuel County—or start your own!
2. Select projects from a list of over 80 choices.
3. Attend monthly club meetings.
4. Build, raise or make projects to exhibit at Achievement Days.
5. Participate in club activities: recreation, tours, trips...there are many things to get involved in.
